Fire Truck Pull ***Saturday, October 3, 2009***

- ✿ This is the United Way of Northern British Columbia's first of, hopefully, many annual truck pull events. It is part of the 2009 United Way Campaign Kick-Off activities. This event is in support of the United Way of Northern British Columbia.
- ✿ This year we will be using a 2008 Spartan/E-One Fire Engine, driven by an experienced Fire Department employee. This truck weighs 17,000 kg, with a crew of four. It is the second-newest engine in the fleet. This truck responds to approximately 3500 calls per year.
- ✿ The teams will be required to pull the truck 50 feet in the shortest amount of time possible. The course will be located on 3rd Avenue next to the Farmer's Market.
- ✿ Each team will consist of a maximum of 10 members. All members must be at least 18 years of age. Teams can be mixed-gender or all male/female members.
- ✿ Each team must obtain a minimum of \$250.00 in pledges in order to compete in the event. The pledge money and waiver must be submitted to the team co-ordinator **before Friday, September 25th, 2009**. Team registration may also be finalized the day of the event provided the team co-ordinator has booked a spot in advance through the United Way office (250.561.1040).
- ✿ Each participant will be required to sign the team registration form (waiver) in order to finalize their registration.
- ✿ The Pull will start at 11:00 a.m. and will end at approximately 12:00 p.m. with award presentations immediately afterwards.
- ✿ Awards will be presented for fastest time, best dressed/most spirited team, and most money raised.
- ✿ There will be plenty of room for spectators, so we encourage everyone to come out and support their favourite team!
