Community and Program

Program Description - Queen Charlotte Islands/Haida Gwaii

Infant Development - Northern Health: Books for Babies

A great relationship builder for service providers and parents at time of inoculation. This program reaches families in all communities on Haida Gwaii.

QCC Child Center: Child Center support

Increase program awareness through advertising efforts, and increase operation and programs in the facility.

Strong Start/ Kindergym: Kindergym material supports

Increasing the attendance to these facilities, opening up the gym to families in the evening access more families.

School Dist. #50: Parent Support Programs

Providing books and materials to parent participation programs for early learning programs. This program reaches families in all communities on Haida Gwaii.

Tiny Tots: Preschool

This community benefits from Tiny Tots, and is in economic need of support for these programs. This grant will subsidise all attending children, allowing them to still attend.

CCRR/ Parent support circles: Program Materials

The parent support circles need kits for active parenting for their circles. Moe the mouse is needed at childcare facilities who have trained facilitators. These supports will benefit all communities on Haida Gwaii.

Mother Goose: Mother Goose

Providing parent participation oral bases language program.

Literacy Haida Gwaii: Imagination Library

Providing 1 book every month to every child until their 5th birthday. Books are sent to children through the mail.

Providing promotion support for existing programs on Haida Gwaii.

Providing material supports for gross and fine motor skills.
