Program Description

Playing to Learn (Prince George)

Program will be run in the new YMCA Early Learning Centre. Program is research based and proven to promote physical, social and emotional skills in children 3 to 5 years old and bolsters readiness for children entering school. (2007 - 2008)

Growing Families (Prince George)

Pilot project for the Prince George Salvation Army to work with their client families. Teaches parents life skills, self help and parenting skills to people who usually don't trust agencies. Provides a quality day care program for children while parents are in class. (2007)

Parent and Tot Drop-In (Pilot Mountain)

Drop-in run by volunteers in a rural community. Social, recreation and literacy program. Sponsored equipment, materials and books. (2007)

Mother Goose (Blackburn, Shelly, Buckhorn, Giscome, Pineview, and Tabor)

Run Mother Goose sessions in for children in rural communities. Train Mother Goose leaders to run sessions for children in rural communities. (2007 - 2008)

Mother Goose (Blackburn, Shelly, Buckhorn, Giscome, Pineview, and Tabor)

Baby Rhyme Time (0 to 18 months) – music movement and stories.
Munchkin Music (18 to 36 months) – development of fine and gross motor skills.
Family Drop-In Music and Stories (0 to 4 years) – instruments, songs and stories. (2007 - 2008)

Active Parenting Now (Prince George)

Pilot project of the Prince George Library to run programs in both of its libraries. 1234 Parents program and Active Parenting. (2007 - 2008)

Hand-in-Hand (Prince George)

(A joint pilot program of Northern Family Health Society and Parent Support Services) A parallel child care program for children of parents who are in education or support groups. For children who have developmental disorders and/or are subject to poverty, addictions, violence or mental health issues. (2007 - 2008)
